- 2 Year Masters Degree
- Accelerated Masters (For Sophomores) with any Degree in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (4+1)
- Dual degrees with Public Administration,
 Geography, American Studies, & Architecture

Curriculum

- 42 Credit Hours
- 24 credit hours of core courses
- 12 credit hours toward a specialization
 - Transportation,
 - Sustainable Land Use, OR
 - Housing & Development
- 6 credit hours allows for tailoring
 - 2nd speciality
